#### **OVERVIEW**

senco's TRACTION GRANT offer \$500 - \$5000 to individuals or organizations looking to explore a social enterprise idea or initiative. Funds can be used for feasibility, testing, piloting or prototyping of a new social enterprise idea, product or service. senco's TRACTION GRANT provides early stage funding so that social entrepreneurs can gain momentum or traction through creative economic experimentation in the growing sector of social enterprise.

#### **KEY DATES**

senco's TRACTION GRANT will be open for submission throughout 2019 and reviewed by one of seven localized Social Enterprise Sector Development Groups (SESDGs) supporting social enterprise development across regions where Georgian College's campuses are located in Central Ontario. Below are the dates in which the EOI must be submitted for review and award.

In 2018 senco facilitated the assembly of localized Social Enterprise Sector Development Groups (SESDGs) across all seven campus communities within the counties of Muskoka, Simcoe, Dufferin and Grey/Bruce. Each SESDG brings together a diverse group of individuals who value innovation and creativity in their approach to social enterprise development and each group includes:

Georgian representation (faculty, leadership or support staff and student)

Representation from intermediary business centres and municipalities

Community and business leaders

Local social enterprise champions

#### **EOI REVIEW PROCESS**

An evaluation matrix will be used by each SESDG to review EOI submissions. Applicants can select which SESDG group they would like to review their EOI submission, only one SESDG will review each submission and we recommend you select the SESDG located closest to you. senco TRACTION GRANT funding can be awarded to social enterprises ideas and initiatives with any business structure or without a formal structure yet in place. It is nevertheless a requirement for senco to allocate 65% of its funding to organizations that are incorporated as not-for-profits.
